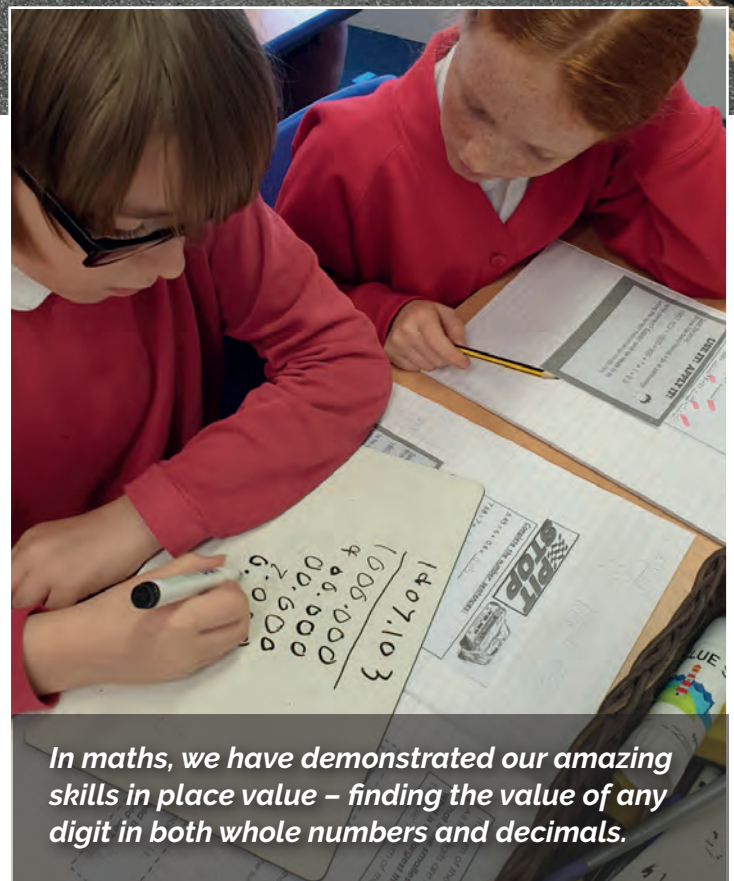


What a fabulous first week our Year 6s have had!
