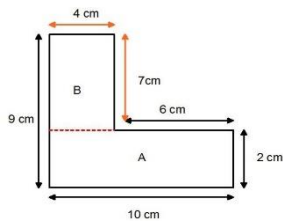


Reading

$$\text{Area} = \frac{1}{2} \times b \times h = \frac{bh}{2}$$

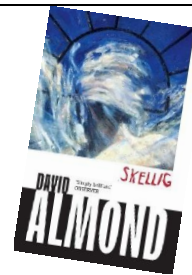
QLA Groups – get ready to practise some more arithmetic with a member of staff!

This week, we are learning words ending in 'shul' spelt 'cial' or 'tial'. For example, **special, official, artificial, financial, partial, essential and confidential**.

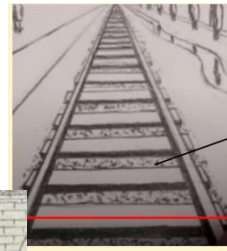
Class Read
